Morning Worship to the Glory of God

Beholding God, Pursuing Righteousness, Proclaiming Christ

Prayer & Preparation: Take some time before we begin to settle your heart and ask for God's blessing as we worship together—both for yourself, your family and the others joining us.

Call to Worship: Have someone in the family read the call as a reminder that this is special time and that we are joining others from the church to praise the name of the Lord together.

***Psalms 47:5-8** God has gone up with a shout, The LORD with the sound of a trumpet. Sing praises to God, sing praises! Sing praises to our King, sing praises! For God is the King of all the earth; Sing praises with understanding. God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne.*

Doxology, #731: The Doxology is a familiar hymn everyone can sing together as you begin.

Praise God from whom all blessings flow; praise Him, all creatures here below; praise Him above, ye heavenly host: praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Amen.

the blessing of the LORD your God that He has given you.”

Scripture Reading: This morning I will be reading online, Daniel 2:1-24.

Message: This morning we will be looking at Psalm 139:11-12.

Benediction: I will offer one at the close of the message.

Hymn: A good closing hymn might be “Soldiers of Christ Arise.”

A Final Prayer: This may be appropriate in your home.
