Morning Worship to the Glory of God

Beholding God, Pursuing Righteousness, Proclaiming Christ

Prayer & Preparation: Take some time before we begin to settle your heart and ask for God's blessing as we worship together—both for yourself, your family and the others joining us.

Call to Worship: Have someone in the family read the call as a reminder that this is special time and that we are joining others from the church to praise the name of the Lord together.

Revelation 5:12 & 13 ...Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing. ...Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him sitting on the throne, and to the Lamb forever and ever.

Doxology, #731: The Doxology is a familiar hymn everyone can sing together as you begin.

Praise God from whom all blessings flow; praise Him, all creatures here below; praise Him above, ye heavenly host: praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Amen.

Opening Hymn: If you have a Trinity Hymnal at home, the hymns about God's creative work in the first third of the Trinity Hymnal. You can check the index of any hymnal or go online to find appropriate hymns for the day.

Reading from the Scripture: I recommend **Ephesians 3** for this morning.

Scripture Reading: This morning I will be reading online, Ecclesiastes 12.

Message: This morning we will be looking at Psalm 139:17-18.

Benediction: I will offer one at the close of the message.

Hymn: A good closing hymn might be “Praise the Savior, You Who Know Him”

A Final Prayer: This may be appropriate in your home.
